- demonstrate and promote adherence to the Club Rules, Policies and Codes of Practice
- display high standards in the use of language, manners and punctuality
- operate within the rules and spirit of rowing, promoting the positive aspects of the sport
- challenge and not condone discrimination on the grounds of gender, race, colour, disability, sexuality, age, religion, political opinion, occupation or marital status
- treat all individuals in the sport with respect at all times, and be fair, honest and considerate
- display control, respect, dignity and professionalism to all involved in rowing promoting tolerance and encouraging mutual respect between participants in the sport
- act in a non-violent and non-threatening way
